Introduction to the Challenge

Hungary's population has a significant overall healthcare burden and life expectancy remains low compared to other countries in Europe. Health is one of the most burning issues of the society and the area of prevention is particularly performing bad.

As part of prevention, early **screening** of individuals would be a highly efficient and the most cost-effective tool to significantly improve health outcomes of the whole population is by helping the early detection of serious/chronic diseases. However, such programs are not yet widely introduced in the country and the health literacy of the general public about the importance of screening is very low. Still, screening is available in state run healthcare institutions (e.g., via General Practitioners) so individuals could seek for such options, but it is not convenient, information is hard to find in an organized matter and people are not motivated anyway.

Your challenge is to build a tailored solution which helps individuals understand the importance of early screening and helps them conveniently get screened in the state healthcare system. The goal of your solution should be to give people a tool that can help with early screening, increase motivation and awareness of this area of healthcare.

We are looking at an online platform like a website or an app. The website is the pull part: users go to search for information. The app is the push part: it notifies users to go to a screening, etc. They should be integrated, working basically as one platform.
